<p><b><u>Lent is a time for Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving</u></b></p> <p><b>PRAYER</b> Join us on Fridays during Lent to pray the Stations of the Cross. All three campuses will be offering this prayer each week.</p> <p><b>FASTING</b> Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting, when Catholics between ages 18 and 59 are obliged to eat no more than one full meal and two smaller meals. All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence, when Catholics age 14 and older are obliged to abstain from eating meat. When health or one's ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.</p> <p><b>ALMSGIVING and FASTING</b> Have you put the CRS Rice Bowl in a prominent place in your home? One long-time tradition is to take the money saved from our Lenten fasting and put it in the rice bowl box. Proceeds from CRS rice bowl help hunger programs worldwide. 25 percent of the proceeds stay right here in Western Washington.</p> <p><b>ALMSGIVING</b> March 15<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> is <b>*Benedict House Dinner Time</b>. St. Gabriel and Prince of Peace parishioners prepare dinners for the residents of Benedict House in Bremerton. Blessed Palms are considered holy objects (sacramentals) and need to be treated with respect. Please dispose of your old palms at your own home. The best way to dispose of palms is either burn them and bury the ashes in ground either in a garden or a place that is undisturbed. If you are unable to burn your palms they can be buried directly into the ground in a respectable way. <b>You should avoid throwing them into the trash or landfills.</b></p><p>In the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation, also called confession, we meet the Lord, who wants to grant forgiveness and the grace to live a renewed life in him. In this sacrament, he prepares us to receive him free from serious sin, with a lively faith, earnest hope, and sacrificial love in the Eucharist. The Church sees confession as so important that she requires that every Catholic go at least once a year. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ’s Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.
