Liturgical Moment

What is an *Indulgence*?

An Indulgence is the remission before God of the temporal punishment due for sins which have already been forgiven as far as their guilt is concerned.

Indulgences are granted by God through the Catholic Church which, as minister of the Redemption, dispenses and applies the treasury of the satisfaction won by Christ and the Saints.

In order to gain an Indulgence, one must be baptized and in the state of grace
And have a general intention of gaining them...

An Indulgence may be gained for oneself or may be offered for the Souls in Purgatory.

A **plenary** Indulgence remits all the punishment due to sin and makes Possible immediate entrance into Heaven after death.

How to Obtain a *Plenary* Indulgence

- I. **Complete ANY one work:**
 - Adore the Blessed Sacrament
 - Pray the Rosary
 - Read the Sacred Scriptures
- II. **Complete ALL actions:**
 - Receive Holy Communion
 - Pray for the Pope's Intentions
 - Intend to Apply this Indulgence
 - God to Confession
 - Be Detached from All Sin

A *Plenary Indulgence*.....

- Releases a soul from Purgatory
 - 1 may be gained each day
