Keep Christ in Christmas Family Advent Activities

The Christmas Adventure Box

Here's how to get started:

Choose which activities you'll be using for your **family advent** and wrap the according items.

Don't forget to attach to each item! Put all of the items into a large box (*The Christmas Adventure Box*) and wrap it also.

Each day that you plan to use the Christmas Adventure Box, you'll unwrap one (or more) of the items and complete that day's devotional/activity.

The first activity card on the advent list sets up the whole idea of the Christmas Adventure Box. However, once you've completed this day, you can do any of the following days in whichever order you choose.

The Christmas Adventure Box

The Greatest Gift

First, bring out the large, wrapped Christmas Adventure Box. Explain to your children that you will be unwrapping an item a few times a week in order to learn more about Jesus this Christmas season.

Read **John 3:16** and talk about how Jesus is the greatest gift of all. You can also read prophecies from Isaiah about the Promised Deliverer. Feel free to share the full gospel with your children and pray together as a family.

The Giving Manger is a fun, interactive Advent tradition that helps families focus on the **true meaning** of Christmas.

It's a visual tool that reminds kids Whose birthday it is!

It also helps them learn how to serve others and make sacrifices for the Baby Jesus.



The Giving Manger comes with a book, a manger, a bundle of "straw," and an adorable Baby Jesus.

Read the story to your kids to help get them get excited for the Advent season.

Then, during the weeks leading up to Christmas, kids (and adults!) can perform simple acts of generosity and kindness or offer up little sacrifices.

Each time an act of generosity or kindness is made, add a piece of straw to the wooden manger.

When Christmas arrives, there will be a cozy resting place for the newborn King, and your family can place Baby Jesus in His manger!
