## Liturgical Moment

*Keep Christ in Christmas Family Advent Activity*

Finding joy – third Sunday in Advent

This weekend is the third Sunday in Advent.

Advent is the time we prepare for Jesus at Christmas time.

So we light the candle for joy, which reminds us of how Jesus brings joy to our lives.
