33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Matthew 25: 14-30

Lectio Divina



Reading (Lectio) : Read the Scripture two or three times.

Meditation (Meditatio) : After the reading, take some time to reflect in silence on one or more of the following questions:

- What word or words in this passage caught your attention?
- What in this passage comforted you? What in this passage challenged you?

Contemplation: What conversion of mind, heart, and life is the Lord asking of me?

But the man who received one went off and dug a hole in the ground and buried his master's money.

What have I done to develop my God-given gifts? When have I hidden my faith instead of giving witness?

Since you were faithful in small matters, I will give you great responsibilities.

What responsibilities has God given me? How does faithfully fulfilling my responsibilities give witness to my faith?

Come, share your master's joy.

How have I experienced God's holy joy this week? How can I share that joy with others?

How can I make my life a gift for others in charity?
