They had had their rent money stolen and couldn't pay rent that month. She needed more help than we could provide. Thanks to sharing, we were able to help her pay rent for the month.

We enjoyed support from our parish during the recent Friends of the Poor Walk. We had about 25 walkers, some new and some repeat walkers from last year. We collected about \$3000.00 for our work of caring for the needy. Thank you for your generous support and especially for your prayers.
