

COVID Precautions - Mass Attendance

We are currently in a COVID surge, and precautionary measures are in place for everyone's protection, especially our young parishioners who are not eligible for vaccination.

As of August 14 2021, in order to protect the health and safety of our parishioners and staff, masks are required in all church buildings, both at Transfiguration and St. Catherine, including during Mass. This is regardless of vaccination status. If you are old enough to safely wear a mask, you are asked to do so. Masks should cover your nose and mouth, face shields are not effective unless combined with a mask.

One section of our church, near the Baptismal Font, is reserved for those who need to social distance in addition to wearing a mask.

If there is a need to communicate a Covid exposure, we will use email and this website. And of course, if you are not feeling well, please attend Mass via our Livestream.
