2017-18 WORKING DOCUMENT

Our School Council held a retreat in September 2017 wherein we revised some goals, reprioritized and attempted to set more specific action steps for this school year.

MISSION STATEMENT

Annunciation Catholic School is a ministry of our parish committed to serving our parish family and community through Catholic education. Our mission is to fully develop each student spiritually, academically, emotionally, and physically according to our Catholic faith in a safe and nurturing environment.

1-3 YEAR GOALS

GOAL 1: HELP EACH CHILD DEVELOP A PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS CHRIST

Annunciation Catholic School recognizes that as a ministry of the parish it has an important responsibility in helping our young people to come to know and follow Jesus Christ. We want to provide an environment where our children can develop their spiritual lives, feel comfortable asking difficult questions about their faith, and be given opportunities to take the next step in their relationship with Christ. It is our goal that every child that passes through our school will be shown the presence of Christ and will be encouraged to know Him more fully.

OBJECTIVE 1: Improve the Catholic aesthetics of our school

Action Step 1: Walk through each campus and assess the presence of Catholic symbols in every area of the school.

Action Step 2: Create a list of potential additions that would increase the expression of our Catholic faith.

Action Step 3: Be intentional about changing decorations during different liturgical seasons.

OBJECTIVE 2: Offer a one-day retreat each year for each campus

Action Step 1: Meet with principals, Evangelization Coordinator, teachers and other interested parties to create a plan.

Action Step 2: Set the date for the retreat for the 2017-18 school year.

Action Step 3: Invite homeschool families to join in the retreat.

OBJECTIVE 3: Provide a variety of prayer opportunities that highlight the rich Catholic tradition of prayer

Action Step 1: Prepare a schedule for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Holy Rosary, Stations of the Cross and other season-specific prayer opportunities.

Action Step 2: Prior to each devotion, ensure that teachers and students are properly catechized to understand what they are entering into.

Action Step 3: Invite parishioners not involved in the school to join the students for these prayer opportunities.

OBJECTIVE 4: Provide opportunities for service in the community

Action Step 1: Principals and teachers will develop a plan for community service projects.

Action Step 2: We will connect each service opportunity with Catholic Social Teaching.

GOAL 2: EMPOWER OUR SCHOOL COMMUNITY TO ACCOMPLISH OUR MISSION

Annunciation Catholic School recognizes that each staff member and each student brings with them a treasure of knowledge and experience. Action Step 3: Encourage faculty and staff to invest in this initiative by offering their suggestions.

Action Step 4: Reassess the strategy used at the end of the school year and make any necessary adjustments.

Action Step 4: Consult the faculty each semester to ask about what other technology might benefit the learning of their students.

3-5 YEAR GOALS:

GOAL 5: STRENGTHEN OUR CONNECTION TO THE LOCAL COMMUNITY

OBJECTIVE 1: Find ways to get local business leaders in our school

Action Step 1: Generate a list of local business leaders from our parish.

Action Step 2: High one or two business leaders to assist us with this endeavor.

Action Step 3: Invite these business leaders to a meeting to discuss our desire for a stronger partnership.

Action Step 4: Develop a plan for better connecting business leaders to our school.

Action Step 5: Establish some long term goals and initiatives between our school and local business leaders in order to sustain these relationships.

OBJECTIVE 2: Connect our students to local colleges

Action Step 1: Establish contacts with the University of Evansville and the University of Southern Indiana.

Action Step 2: Meet with these contacts individually to discuss a possible partnership.

Action Step 3: Consider how our school graduates present at these universities might serve as ambassadors to our students.

Action Step 4: Establish a plan based on the needs of our students on how to help our students prepare for college now.

Action Step 5: Establish some long-term goals and initiatives between our school and University leaders in order to sustain these relationships.

OBJECTIVE 3: Consider the possibility and impact of bussing for students

Action Step 1: Generate and implement a survey to determine the need for bussing.

Action Step 2: If there is a need, determine the cost of providing bussing for our students.

Action Step 3: Decide if the cost is justified by the need.

Action Step 4A: If the cost is not justified by the need, then consider how other school bus routes might benefit our school children.

Action Step 4B: If the cost is justified by the need, discuss this possibility with the Catholic Schools Office and get their input on the best course of action.

GOAL 6: BECOME A 4-STAR SCHOOL IN THE STATE OF INDIANA

OBJECTIVE 1: Improve our standardized test scores

1A: All students at Christ the King Campus from Kindergarten through 8th grade will demonstrate appropriate individual growth in Reading from the beginning of the school year assessment to the end of the year assessment.

Action Step 1: Teachers will meet collaboratively throughout the school year to review data from the Star Reading assessments.

Action Step 2: Teachers will administer tests at least 5 times during the school year and record results in student data notebooks.

Action Step 3: Teachers will use this data to drive instruction and differentiate their lessons to meet the individual needs of each child.

Action Step 4: Professional development will be available for teachers on an as needed basis.

1B: All students Kindergarten through 8th grade will demonstrate appropriate individual growth in Math from the beginning of the school year assessment to the end of the year assessment.

Action Step 1: Teachers will meet collaboratively throughout the school year to review data from the Star Reading assessments.

Action Step 2: Teachers will administer tests at least 5 times during the school year and record results in student data notebooks.

Action Step 3: Teachers will use this data to drive instruction and differentiate their lessons to meet the individual needs of each child.

Action Step 4: Professional development will be available for teachers on an as needed basis.

1C: Holy Spirit Students will increase mastery of non-fiction/informational text.

Action Step 1: Holy Spirit Campus will provide professional development in teaching strategies, assessment implementation, AR 360 and using data to drive instruction for non-fiction/informational text for all faculty members.

Action Step 2: Teachers will encourage students in their efforts to grow this area.

Action Step 3: All teachers will be trained in AR 360.

1D: Holy Spirit students will demonstrate growth in mathematical standards including Number Sense, Computation, Algebra & Functions, Geometry, Measurement, and Problem Solving.

Action Step 1: Holy Spirit Campus will provide professional development in teaching strategies, assessment implementation, AR 360 and using data to drive instruction for these areas for all faculty members.

Action Step 2: Teachers will use Title I, Title II, and additional budget funds for Professional Development in this area.

Action Step 3: The STAR Math tool will be used as a marker for student growth in these areas.

Action Step 4: Students who are not growing will be given additional attention to advance in these areas.

OBJECTIVE 2: Find ways to offer further support for students

Action Step 1: Assess the needs of our students in the areas of academic life, spiritual life and family life.

Action Step 2: Work with priests, teachers, parents and other community experts to develop a plan to respond to those needs.

Action Step 3: Find ways to encourage students in small successes and to help them feel part of a larger family (see Objective 3 below for greater detail).

Action Step 4: Maintain relationships with students through high school and college.

Action Step 4A: Maintain a list of graduates and ensure one teacher or school council member is assigned to each student.

Action 4B: Develop a program for correspondence that is appropriate for each student's circumstances.

OBJECTIVE 3: Celebrate the accomplishments of our students

Action Step 1: Determine criteria for highlighting an "Angel of the Month" from each campus in our parish bulletin.

Action Step 2: Revamp Honor's Night to make it more elaborate and more of a celebration of student achievement.

Action Step 3: Have the Principal or Teacher Liaison identify one student per month that should be congratulated by our School Council for some achievement.

Action Step 3a: Have the School Council write a hand-written card and signed by the Council to be delivered to the student.

Action Step 4: Develop a method for sharing student accomplishments on Social Media.
