Must be 4 years old by
September 1, 2018

Children in the three and four year old classes must be fully potty trained by the start of school. No pull-ups allowed.

All staff members:

-Participate in *VIRTUS Protecting God's Children* through the Archdiocese of Atlanta's Office of Child and Youth Protection.

-Maintain certification in CPR and First Aid.

-Obtain 10 hours of required continuing education classes through the Archdiocese of Atlanta Summer Institute, the Georgia Preschool Conference, and other educational opportunities each school year.

Registration:

\$125 per student

Resource/Activity:

Twos Class	\$90

Fours Class	\$130

Registration and resource fees are due at the time of enrollment. These fees are non-refundable.

Tuition:

Twos Class	\$198
Threes Class	\$262
Fours Class	\$295

The monthly tuition is divided into nine payments. The first payment is due May 1, 2018. The second tuition payment is due September 1, 2018, with the remaining tuition payments due on the first of each month through April 2019.
