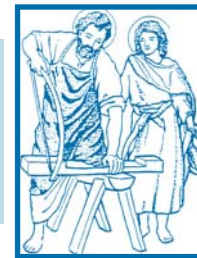

HOW TO LIVE LIKE GLENN?

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory.
