In Elford Hall from 1-2:30 p.m.

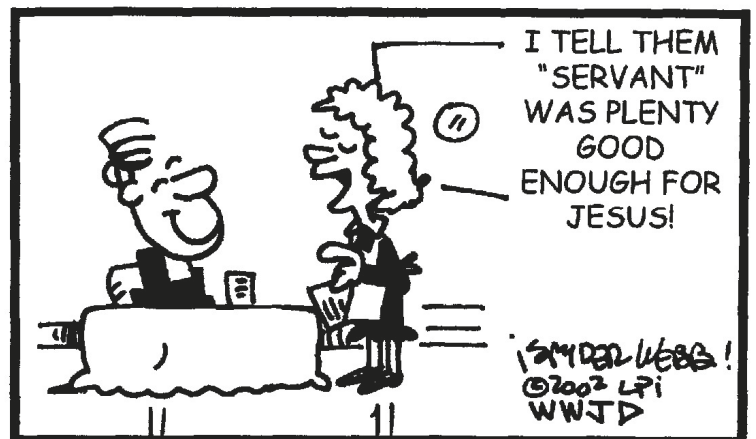
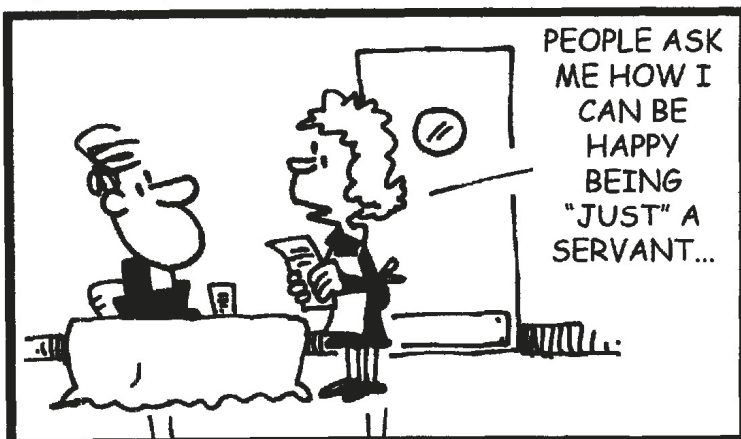
