A VISIBLE GOD

We find it difficult to convey ideas to people unless we can actually show them something. God, who is invisible and truly beyond human understanding, apparently faces the same difficulty. People want to see, not just listen to an idea. So God gave us Jesus Christ, God made visible in the world.

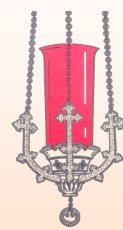
During these past weeks we have seen how Jesus was revealed as an infant to the shepherds and the magi, and then began His adult public life at His Baptism by John. Today's Gospel reading tells us of His first sign, providing wine for the wedding guests at Cana. Of course, even Jesus, was not always easily understood in His own day, nor is He even now. So we have to ponder what we see: the poverty and simplicity of His birth, His humility and openness before John the Baptist, His kindness and compassion toward people in their ordinary problems, such as running short of wine at a wedding. Yet it is in coming to know Jesus that we come to know God.

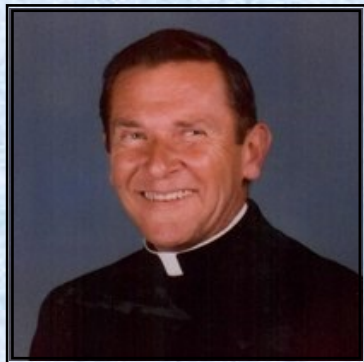

Fr. Henry John Januszkiewicz 1937-2019

From 2015 until the time of his passing, Fr. Henry had been assisting at Church of the Resurrection of Our Lord.

He was born February 4, 1937, a native of Newark, NJ and was ordained May 26, 1962 at St. Matthews Cathedral in Washington, DC after studying for the priesthood at St. Bonaventure University and Christ the King Seminary from 1956 – 1962 in Olean, NY. Prior to this, he studied at Seton Hall University in South Orange, NJ. While pursuing his studies for the priesthood, he also received his Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy and Theology.

Fr. Henry celebrated his first Mass on May 27, 1962 at St. Stanislaus Parish in Newark, NJ. For the first 6 years of his priesthood, he served as Parochial Vicar at St. Thomas Moore in SE Washington, DC from 1962-1968. He was then assigned to The Children's Center for Delinquent and Dysfunctional Children in Laurel, MD, St. Patrick's Church in NW Washington, DC, St. Mary's Church in Landover, MD and Annunciation Catholic Church in NW Washington, DC before being assigned as Pastor to Ascension Catholic Church in Bowie, MD.

Fr. Henry established a personal relationship with Pope John Paul II. At the Vatican, Fr. Henry concelebrated morning Mass with Pope John Paul II in his private chapel then having breakfast afterward made by John Paul's private nuns.

After health problems arose in 1994 he retired from the Archdiocese of Washington and moved to SW Florida. He assisted at St. Raphael's Catholic Church in Lehigh Acres, FL from 1996-2006 as well as St. Leo the Great Catholic Church in Bonita Springs, FL from 1996-2015.

Statement of the Catholic Bishops of Florida on the 46th Anniversary of *Roe v. Wade* January 22, 2019

"So great is the value of a human life, and so inalienable the right to life of an innocent child growing in the mother's womb, that no alleged right to one's own body can justify a decision to terminate that life, which is an end in itself and which can never be considered the 'property' of another human being."

- Pope Francis, *Amoris Laetitia*, no. 83

On this annual Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children, we pray that the Lord enlighten the eyes of our hearts and lead our nation out of the darkness of the decision to legalize abortion 46 years ago. On this anniversary, we pray for those whom we will never know, and we pray for their mothers and fathers who have suffered this loss. We pray for each other that our enlightenment will lead us to honor the sacredness of each life, given to us by God for God.

However, we are encouraged by having celebrated this last year another anniversary – that of *Humanae Vitae* – and the canonization of its author, Saint Pope Paul VI. This prophetic encyclical shook the world 50 years ago with its countercultural instruction rejecting artificial contraception and welcoming children as gifts from God that are part of married love. Yet, today, growing numbers of women of all faiths and no faith are rejecting artificial contraception and realizing that fertility is not a disease to be "treated." Rather, spouses are discovering natural family planning as it promotes healthy reproduction, healthy relationships, and a healthy environment.

Similarly, we are convinced that the Church's teaching on abortion is continuously proving to be prophetic. Our nation is increasingly rejecting abortion and *Roe v. Wade* as states continue to adopt more limitations on abortion and expand alternatives to abortion. During the 2018 legislative session, the people of God and others of good will, through the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops, advocated for the addition of the Florida Pregnancy Care Network to Florida statutes. This legislation better positions a network of over 100 pregnancy support centers across our state to support women who choose life for their unborn children, even when facing an unplanned pregnancy.

Yet, there is still much work to be done. We are appalled at the current "assembly line" approach by abortionists to the irreversible decision of the mother for her and the defenseless child within her womb. While physicians ensure patients are fully informed prior to other serious medical procedures, Florida courts invoked the right to privacy in our state constitution to block a good law requiring a 24-hour reflection period prior to abortion, pending appeal.

The court's broad interpretation of our state's privacy clause stems from a Florida Supreme Court ruling in 1989 against a law requiring parental consent prior to a minor's abortion and poses unique challenges regarding abortion laws in Florida. We advocate for the reconsideration of these decisions, and we remain hopeful that the courts will ultimately protect women in Florida from the predatory practices of the abortion industry. Otherwise, even if *Roe v. Wade* were overturned, the state of Florida could retain permissive abortion policies.

We join together today renewing our cry for an end to everything which denies the sacredness of life, including the unacceptable judicial decision in *Roe v. Wade* and the interpretation of Florida's privacy clause favoring abortion. We ask God to help us to protect unborn children and their families, and to grant wisdom and courage for those in elected office. May our Lord Jesus Christ enlighten the eyes of our hearts, that we may recognize that devaluing the most innocent and vulnerable life leads to a coarseness and callousness towards one another and all life.

FLU SEASON HAS ARRIVED!

The flu comes on suddenly, and symptoms may vary. Most common flu symptoms include, fever, headaches, body aches, fatigue, a dry cough and chills and sweats. If you have these symptoms you should seek medical attention immediately. Occasionally, they also include stuffy or runny nose, sneezing, sore throat, and nausea. This can make it hard to differentiate from a common cold.

Highest risk for the flu are the elderly, very young, and those with medical conditions. The CDC recommends everyone 6 months and older receive a flu shot every year. It is a MYTH that the flu shot can give you the flu. If you do experience flu like symptoms after your vaccine, you were probably exposed to the flu virus. This could occur shortly before getting vaccinated, or during the 2 week period after vaccination that it takes the body to develop immune protection.

Some drug stores offer flu shots for those 18 and older, and no appointment is required. For Medicare and most insurances, there is no charge. If you do not have insurance, costs vary from \$30-40.

Let's all do our part to keep each other healthy.

Remember: it's not too late to vaccinate!

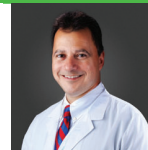
