SUNDAY OUTDOOR MASS New Time 2:00PM. Gates closed at 2PM.

If you are sick or symptomatic (fever, new cough, fatigue, etc.), or you have been in contact with someone who tested positive, who is sick or symptomatic in the last 2 weeks, please remain at home.

- We ask all attendees to wash their hands for 20 seconds with soap and warm water before leaving home. We will provide sanitizer for your hands when you enter the gate.
- Arrive at least 10 minutes before Mass in order to accommodate the check-in process.
- No admittance after 2:00pm. Gates will be closed at 2:00pm
- Each individual, ages 2 and up, will be required to wear a face mask. You must wear your face mask for the entire time that you are on Holy Angels campus and during the entire Mass. (The mask must cover your nose and mouth.)
- Physical Distance must be respected at all times. Everyone must follow the ushers' directions and keep a minimum 6 feet of physical distance at all times.
- Collection basket will be at the entrance gate for your donation.
- You will be directed to your seat by an usher you must sit where you are directed. You may not choose your own seat.
- Ushers will direct you at Communion time.
- Communion will be administered at the end of Mass with your masks in place.
- You will approach the Minister with your mask in place hold your hands in front
 of you to receive the Body of Christ. Then you will move 6 feet to the side (in the
 marked spot), consume the host and exit the area to return to your car. You will
 not return to your chair.
- Communion will ONLY be given in the hand.
- There will be no congregating or socializing after the Mass. People are to go directly to their cars and return home.
- No restroom facilities will be open at this time.

The Archdiocese, following the protocols of medical authorities has given us the guidelines above that we must follow for the health and safety of others.

We encourage anyone in a vulnerable population, including those with chronic health conditions, to come to the In-Car Communion Procession on Sunday morning and to watch a televised or livestream Mass from the safety of their homes. IMPORTANT NOTE:

If you are sick or symptomatic (fever, cough, fatigue, etc.), or you have been in contact with someone who is sick or symptomatic in the last 2 weeks, please remain at home.

We are happy to offer the gift of the Eucharist to all our parishioners and friends! Everyone must follow the guidelines below to receive Communion.

- 1. Enter the parking lot from Holly Avenue.
- 2. Follow the signs and the orange cones in the parking lot.
- 3. All those to receive Holy Communion must wear masks inside the car.
- 4. You must remain inside your car at all times.
- 5. As you approach the Communion stations, you will be asked to open your windows and receive sanitizer for your hands. You must sanitize your hands before receiving Holy Communion.
- 6. Holy Communion may be received only in the hand.
- 7. Eucharistic Ministers, wearing masks, will be on both sides of each car to distribute Communion.
- 8. After receiving Holy Communion, lower your mask to consume the Eucharist. Keep your mask on until you have pulled away.
- 9. Drive out of the parking lot.
- 10. Watch Mass at home on Sundays from our holyangelsarcadia.org or on our Facebook page.

Reminder: The church and facilities will not be open. No restrooms will be available.

Tax Benefits for Charitable Giving Extended through 2021

On December 27, 2020, legislation was enacted that extended tax benefits for charitable giving through 2021. These special tax benefits were originally set to expire at the end of 2020.

Here is a summary of these benefits:

- Charitable deduction limitations for cash gifts. For 2021, these deductions may again offset up to 100% of your adjusted income. In 2022, the deduction limitation for cash gifts will return to 60%.
- IRA gifts for individuals age 59½ and older. Due to the extension described above, you may withdraw money from your IRA to make cash charitable gifts in 2021 and avoid having to pay taxes on the IRA distribution. This opportunity will not be available in 2022.
- Universal deduction. Individuals may claim a charitable deduction of up to \$300, and married couples filing jointly may claim up to \$600, even without itemizing the deductions.



Jesus taught Nicodemus that God sent His only Son into the world to offer eternal life to believers. Who in your life needs to hear this message?


3 EASY STEPS

DON'T TOUCH YOUR FACE


Especially around the eyes, nose and mouth. If you must sneeze, use a tissue or your arm.
