





What to do if a child discloses abuse to a peer

Abuse victims often struggle to disclose what has happened to them, especially children. This struggle may be due to fear or shame, but studies show it is easier for children to disclose abuse to a trusted person. In adolescence, that is often another peer. This makes it important to educate children about what to do if a friend discloses abuse. Teach children the importance of not keeping unsafe secrets, and how to help their friends by sharing these "secrets" with a trusted parent or other adult. Our Parishioner CARIDAD PAPA 110 YEARS YOUNG

We are very proud to announce an outstanding milestone: the 110th birthday of our beloved parishioner, Caridad Papa.

It is rare when a person celebrates 100 years of life. But it is truly extraordinary to reach 110! At this point one is known as a "Supercentenarian." Statistics change from day to day, of course, but at the time of this writing there appear to be just 53 supercentenarians in the United States. All but three of these are women!

Born August 14, 1913 in Macate, Philippines, Caridad is affectionately known as "Lola,"

which means "Grandmother" in Tagalog. One of eleven children, she is the last of her generation still living. She had five children of her own and is now a great-great grandmother. She has been living here since the 1990s.

Lola has a great sense of humor, a good memory, and a profound faith. The highlight of her week is receiving Holy Communion. She loves to come to Mass when she is able, where she sits in the front pew.

When asked what the secret is to her longevity, Lola points to heaven and says, "God. God is the only one." Similarly, when asked how long she would like to remain on earth, she replies with a smile, "God is the only one who knows. I just leave everything to God."


