



Advent begins today. Advent is a period of simple living and extra prayer. It is a time to prepare for a new coming of Jesus our Savior. ADVENT PENANCE SERVICES


Holy Angels Church on Wednesday, December 13 at 7pm




DECORATE OUR CHURCH FOR CHRISTMAS!


