





Advent begins in 2 weeks. Advent is a period of simple living and extra prayer. It is a time to prepare for a new coming of Jesus our Savior. During Advent, we try to prepare our homes and our lives for Jesus, the King of glory and the Prince of peace. Mark these four weeks of preparation with an Advent wreath in your home. Each Sunday of Advent, we are asked to bring our Advent candle for that week to Mass with us. We will light our candle from our church's Advent wreath as a sign of our community and unity as a parish family. So that everyone can take part in this tradition here at Holy Angels, we will have boxes of Advent candles available in the gathering center for a nominal fee. 
