

Talking with your children

It is good practice for parents to have ongoing conversations with their children about family values, safety, and "what if" scenarios. Even if these conversations feel huge or overwhelming, they are critical to have. Start small – perhaps in the car on the way to school or a game – and build on previous conversations to give your child a full picture of what to do and how to handle tricky situations. FLU SHOTS COMING!! Sunday October 15 8am to 12:30pm

If you are 18 or older, you can get a free flu shot. You don't need an appointment, but we would suggest you make one, for we have a limited supply of vaccines.

Please note, we do not have a high-dose vaccine for people who are 65 or older. You can get it from your pharmacy or doctor. We thank USC Arcadia Hospital and our Health Ministry Parish Nurses for providing this service. To get a flu shot, you must meet these requirements:

- You have no allergies to previous flu shots
- You are not pregnant
- You have no history of Guillain-Barre Syndrome
- You have not tested positive for Covid in the last 14 days
- You feel well
- Wash your hands before coming
- Bring your own pen
- Wear short sleeves
- Mask recommended


