



#### **SCHOOL HISTORY**

Did you know that Holy Angels School has the oldest licensed Pre-Kindergarten program in the Los Angeles Archdiocese? The Pre-k program was started in 1999 as an overflow class because the Kindergarten class was at capacity. Since then it has evolved into an early education department which includes a Pre-K, which serves 3 year olds, Transitional Kindergarten (TK), which serves 4 year olds and Kindergarten (5-6 year olds). The PK and TK program introduces academic concepts, as well as fosters the students social and emotional development. In addition the kids participate in extracurricular classes such as music, PE, Spanish and technology. Kindergarten follows the California state standards as well as the standards set by the archdiocese. Kindergarten students also participate in the same extracurricular classes, as well as a formal art class. "We are blessed to be given the opportunity to teach God's littlest ones," says Mrs. Elvira Gaona, Early Ed Director.

Each week you have read about what's happening at Holy Angels, now is your chance to come see it in person! Holy Angels School will be hosting their Open House on Sunday, January 28th from 10am-12pm. This is a great opportunity to see student work, meet and talk to the teachers and check out the school facilities. We hope to see you there!




