

## **Foothill Unity Center**

We are helping to support our community's most vulnerable residents, especially people experiencing loss of homes from the Eaton Fire and homelessness. We will donate essential supplies that Foothill Unity can distribute to our neighbors each month. Drop off your donations in the boxes inside the church. Needed Items for August: Hygiene products, travel size toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, deodorant, lotion, small packages of handi-wipes, lip balm, sunscreen and nail clippers.

Foothill Unity Center is in our 45th year of service to the SGV community. Out of our two locations, Monrovia and Pasadena, we serve between 1,500 and 2,000 unduplicated clients each month through 6 weekly food distributions, hot meal programs, shower programs, housing and social service case management, and more. Volunteers are the heart of our operations and we cannot do this essential work without them.

Our greatest need for volunteers is during our food distributions, which happen thrice weekly at each of our sites. In Monrovia, they are Monday/Wednesday/Friday from 8:30am-12pm, and in Pasadena Tuesday/Wednesday/Friday from 8:30am-11:30am.



This week marks a joyful milestone for Holy Angels—our solar carport project is nearly complete! The Mesa Solar Team has finished all remaining work, including ADA accessibility upgrades, and the City of Arcadia has conducted and approved final inspections. With demobilization wrapped up, the construction fence has been removed, and the entire area is now open for our parish family to use.

We are delighted to welcome you to park under the shade of our new solar carport when you come to Mass. This beautiful structure not only adds comfort and convenience but also stands as a visible sign of our parish's commitment to sustainability and care for creation. While the EV charging stations and Edison's formal Permission to Operate are still pending, all major improvements—electrical installation, ADA upgrades, and city approvals—are complete.

Thank you for your patience, prayers, and support throughout this project. Your enthusiasm helped make this green initiative possible, and we look forward to it serving our community for years to come. 


