

Flu Vaccine Clinic Today, Sunday October 12 8:00AM TO 12:30PM Parish Hall

Holy Angels, in partnership with USC Arcadia Hospital and Health Ministries, will host a flu vaccine clinic.

The CDC recommends annual flu shots for everyone 6 months and older. This clinic will serve adult parishioners (18+) with the standard trivalent vaccine (not the high-dose version for those 65+).

Do not get vaccinated if you have had a severe allergic reaction to a flu vaccine ingredient, a history of Guillain -Barré syndrome, are currently ill, or have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days.

Help reduce the spread of respiratory illnesses—wear a short-sleeved shirt. Appointment not needed.



SCHOOL STUDENT NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICY




Adoration every month, after the 8:30 am Mass and ends at noon.

DID YOU KNOW?

About the Take It Down Act

The federal TAKE IT DOWN Act was recently signed into law. It criminalizes the publication of nonconsensual intimate images, including Al-generated images. Anyone who publishes or threatens to publish such images online can be charged with a crime and prosecuted. Websites are also required to take down nonconsensual intimate images, if a victim asks, within 48 hours of the request. This new law is important for protecting minors and all potential victims of sexual abuse or violence. 
