



Shroud Presentation: March 2, 6:30pm in the church "Who is the Man in the Shroud?"

Holy Angels Parish, in partnership with www.Othonia.org, cordially invites you to be part of a special presentation of The Shroud of Turin. The study of the Shroud of Turin lies at the intersection of faith and science. It provides the opportunity for believers and skeptics alike to probe, question, and ponder the mysterious image on a linen cloth of a man with the wounds described in the Gospel accounts of the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Jesus.

The evening will take place at Holy Angels Church on March 2nd, 2026, at 6:30pm and will be presented by Nora Creech, a graduate of Shroud Studies through Othonia, a non-profit educational and research organization dedicated to the Shroud of Turin. The event will include a lecture by Nora Creech, replicas of the Shroud, weapons of the Passion and a question-and-answer session. 




Outdoor Stations of the Cross




Stations of the Cross on Fridays of Lent 7pm in church

Adult Confirmation Classes


Beginning Thursday March 5, 7PM
