Sign up for Mass for the Week of September 12 - 18

A new link is now available to sign up for Mass for the week of September 12 - 18. **This is a [NEW link](#).** Please read all instructions carefully before signing up.

IF YOU WISH TO ATTEND 8AM WEEKLY MASS, PLEASE READ THE INFORMATION AT THE BOTTOM OF THIS EMAIL. WE ASK THAT YOU SIGN UP FOR WEEKDAY 8AM MASS AS OUR STUDENTS ARE ATTENDING AGAIN.

REMINDER: It is a requirement to sign up for the Mass you wish to attend. Growing numbers of walk-ins are causing unnecessary delays when checking in your fellow parishioners who are using the signup system as requested. Also, we are only allowed 125 people in attendance and need to be sure we stay within the attendance guidelines. Our signup sheets for the weekend are printed off on Saturday and placed in the Vestibule for our Ushers for the weekend Masses. If you could sign up by Friday night, it would be very helpful with the check-in process. Thank you for your understanding.

In compliance with the Executive Order issued by Governor Polis, face coverings will continue be required at all Masses.

Please remember to arrive at least 5 minutes early to Mass so you can check-in and be seated before Mass begins. Also, we ask that you keep getting up and

moving around during Mass to a minimum, no one should be standing in the Vestibule unless you need to take your child out of the Church and please do not leave before Mass has ended.

Our weekday Mass, Monday - Friday at 8am, is streamed live on [Facebook](#). You can also watch it live on our [website](#) or [app](#). We are also still offering Tuesday and Thursday evening Masses.

Students Going Back To Mass

Our St. Paul Students have returned to daily Mass. If you haven't already, please review the below information so we can ensure our students, parents and Parishioners can attend Mass safely. Our students will go to Mass on a rotation schedule. Monday, Wednesday and Friday will be 5th – 8th with one class sitting in the choir loft. Tuesday and Thursday will be K-4. All students will sit on the right hand side (if you were standing at the altar). All students will exit through the back and middle doors on the right hand side (if you were standing at the altar).

- Adults – please sit on the opposite side of the Church as the students
 - Please exit either through the front door directly to the parking lot or the back door on the left hand side (if you were standing at the altar)
 - Please exit to the parking lot through the far left door, do not use the main Church doors
 - Adults should stay in pew until the children have exited the Church. Parents, please do not sit with or move around to find your child(ren) after Mass
 - 1 person or couple per kneeler – please be attentive to allowing others into the pew

- Masks are required – all students will have them on
- Please maintain 6 ft, our isles are marked and sit in available pews
- PLEASE BE ON TIME
- PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE EARLY
- PLEASE LIMIT MOVEMENT THROUGHOUT THE MASS

Please remember that these guidelines are put in place to keep everyone safe, healthy and attending Mass regularly. Our signup procedure is to ensure we are within our attendance restriction numbers and to be able to notify all attending Parishioners if there is an outbreak at the school.
