Legislative Update → full update on meeting recording at approximately 39 or 40 minutes in.

- No bills of interest got passed
 - We may have special session calls for pre-agreed upon issues
- Senate crime bill had interesting enhancements as far as punishment
 - Included crimes against pregnant women to say there's a 2nd victim
 - 2 crimes 1 against the woman and 1 against the unborn child

- Picked up votes on Equal Rights amendment from last time picked up 2 votes
- Also picked up a few pro-life democrat votes that we didn't have last year to get licensing at abortion clinics
- At federal level, if Roe is overturned, there might be one more attempt to pass pro-abortion legislation and to overturn the filibuster
 - Court will likely release decision in late June
- Hyde amendment is protected for the moment through September 30th.
- Don touches on MN and how we are probably a pro-life state, even if it doesn't seem like it with all of our pro-abortion policies
 - Dennis Prager podcast recommendation
- When will MCCL publish a voter's guide? Per Don, it will be out in early July, but polls open June (24th?), so hopefully the guide will be provided earlier
