### Don Parker - Legislative updates

- US House passed Appropriation Bill
  - Does not include Hyde Amendment
  - Does not include Helms Amendment
  - Does not include Weldon Amendment
- Senate will likely not pass this Appropriation Bill
  - Needs 60 votes to pass
    - If Republicans and the 1-2 pro-life Democrats hold firm, then they'll have to continue funding the government. Current Policy says we do not pay for abortions.
  - What might make Democrats blink sometimes the party that gets blamed for shutting down the government is the party that has the power.
  - As pro-lifers, we must continue to pray and operate as if a government shutdown will be the outcome. We should be calling/contacting our elected officials to make our voices heard.
