Legislative Huddle (MCCL) - Don Parker Dparker@mccl.org

- State level
  - Bill to challenge states to ban abortion funding abortion funding brought into MN legislature in 1994
    - When state and federal levels do not fund abortions, ½ of those abortions actaully happen.
  - Bill to stop funding abortion clinics
  - o Bill to require inspections & licensing of abortion clinics
    - Help bring more to light the real atrocities that go on inside
  - Bill to legalize assisted suicide watching this closely
  - Bill Positive Alternative state help funding crisis pregnancy centers (pregnancy resource centers) - centers could get up to \$250,000 in grants to provide services to help save lives
- Federal level
  - President Biden gave more funding to Planned Parenthood & operations/groups that set up abortions overseas
  - More money for Planned Parenthood in the Covid relief bill and there could be more money provided to PP in other bills too
  - Potential free speech provisions may rise up that would limit the free speech of the Church
  - Changing the Equal Rights Amendment
    - Abortion Neutralization Amendment
- National level
  - Most legislation has to be passed by 60 votes
    - Should help with keeping big pro-choice moves at bay until we have a new makeup of the senate/house
- Tom asked about the filibuster elimination if it's gone, it would only take 50 votes to pass legislation

Barbara has asked what are the urgent things that could be done in our community as Calls to Action

- Don can send list of call to action items & contact info for legislators
- One of the biggest things is to call, write, or email our legislators and ask them to support ending taxpayer-funding for abortion

- This message needs to be sent strongly and consistently
- Of all the threats right now at the federal level, it's the filibuster elimination
  - We need to try to preserve the filibuster!!!
