- Spiritual Adoption Program (School)

- Diaper Chest Plans
 - Tom Dunne takes donations and locks them up until we have enough to make a drop
 - Diaper situation is serious very expensive
 - Debate whether distribution to Pregnancy Resource Centers is quarterly or monthly
 - o HC collections Judy has a contact to collect donations and bring to Abria
- Gerald found something online Everlife Diapers is a national group (Prolife) that has started a diaper service - sort of a subscription service - we're not sure how prices compare to prices in stores - Everlife makes the diapers themselves. Public Square started this service.
 - Could be a good way of sponsoring regular donations to be able to bring over to local pregnancy resource centers
