## Legislative Huddle w/ Don Parker

- Exemption doesn't just apply to babies who survived abortion, but any child No prosecution for babies that are left to die
  - This is shocking people people are troubled by this
  - o Could be a wedge issue, like partial birth abortion
    - People for some reason cannot always see a child within the womb
  - Draft of letter to legislators written by Don Parker (in 9/5/23 agenda copy)
- The number of abortions in MN went up from 10,000 per year to 12,000 per year
  - In part because of the decision to take away parental rights
  - We're on a monthly pace for next year to show 16,000 abortions in 2024
  - MCCL planning a somber commemorative service to remember the 12,000 lives of MN babies lost
    - Hoping to get many more people to come to next March for Life.
- MCCL is planning to hire more team members to create a Pro-Life culture in MN
  - Outreach
    - Youth
    - Hispanic
  - MN is not far off from where IA used to be very pro-abortion turned pro-life/conservative
    - If IA can do it, MN can too
- MCCL informed legislature of the democrat legislator in a tough district had to resign
  - If we can get a Republican into that district, it could give the leftist legislators pause
- Fall tour MoM/HC is hosting again this year
  - Dates coming yet to be published
- Abortion reporting laws were changed
  - Chemical and surgical abortions still need to be reported
  - Took out the need to report complications with chemical abortions
  - Biden got rid of medical visits & followup visits
    - There will be many women hurt/harmed by chemical abortions
    - Many lawsuits
    - This will be a very big issue
