Annunciation Catholic Church in Minneapolis

Sometimes there really are no words. At times like this, when innocent children and adults at Annunciation School in Minneapolis are killed and wounded at Mass, the horror of such senseless violence goes beyond the power of words to express the outrage and grief we feel. And yet words are all we have, at this time, to convey our solidarity with the entire Annunciation community. Even Jesus was rendered speechless for a time at the death of his friend Lazarus, and the shortest verse in scripture -- "And Jesus wept" -- shows us that, at times like these, tears are the most authentic human response to loss and pain. All of us at St. Greg's weep for and with the victims and their families and friends. We pray for them and pray that we may be peacemakers in our corners of the world.

The following is a statement from Archbishop Grob.

Please join me in praying for the victims and families of those who were killed and injured in the shooting at Annunciation Catholic Church and School this morning. Our hearts break for the families and communities who have been traumatized by violence, especially during the sacred celebration of Mass. As Psalm 34:19 tells us: "The Lord is close to the brokenhearted, saves those whose spirit is crushed."

During times like this we need to lean into our faith, hold each other up, and be compassionate to each other, recognizing the dignity of each person we encounter.

Know that my prayers are also with our teachers, staff and students for a safe and blessed school year. The start of a school year is supposed to be a time of anticipation and new beginnings — I hope that is not diminished by this tragedy.
