






Installation of Officers 2023-2024 Columbian Pear

Rev. Monsignor Domenick Graziadio, passed away on Monday, November 13, 2023. He became an Ordained a priest on January 22, 1966. Named a Prelate of Honor (Monsignor) on August 1, 1966. He served as a faculty member at St. Pius X Seminary, Uniondale, NY; as Associate Pastor at St. Joseph Church, Ronkonkoma, NY, Holy Family Church, Hicksville, NY and as Pastor of St. Rocco Church, Glen Cove, NY, as Pastor at St. Cyril & Methodius Church, Deer Park, NY and a Pastor at St. Pius X Church, Plainview, NY. Msgr. Graziadio retired in 2013.

Msgr. Dom is remembered fondly for his dedication and service to the Parish Family at St. Pius X. He attended many Knights of Columbus events and Socials. He was a huge supporter of our Council and with Phil Saglimbene, PGK, (3), Neil DeRosa, PGK, and myself we served on his Pastoral Advisory Committees. He was always no nonsense and all business at these meetings. He also listened and would use well intentioned advice. He would also interject his religious guidance and humor during and after these meetings. I remember fondly his Homilies. He spoke so well without the use of notes. He was an eloquent, articulate, and forceful speaker. Many times, after a particularly meaningful Homily you would hear the word "Wow". He knew so much about our Church, Religion, and the Bible. He inspired and comforted us with his words and deeds. Rest In Peace!


