Dear Parishioners,

As we wish Fr. Glen all the best as he assumes his new responsibilities as Administrator of Our Lady of the Assumption parish in Woodbridge, I want to offer a few words of explanation during this time of transition.

Please know that I have arranged coverage for all weekday and weekend Masses for the remaining two weeks of March. I am grateful for Fr. Jack Pahl and Fr. Than Nguyen who have offered their help in celebrating these additional Masses. However, my challenge will be to meet the demands of funerals, sick calls, baptisms, etc. In light of this, I am grateful for Deacon Brian Armstrong (St. Matthew's) and Deacon Rich Wisniewski (Ret.) who also are committed to help as needed.

The good news is that, at least for the month of April, there will be a priest-in residence at St. Gregory's who will cover most of the daily and weekend responsibilities—including Holy Week—until he assumes his new assignment in May. Of course, our hope is that by May a new priest-in-residence will be assigned to St. Gregory's.

Given the current situation, I ask for your patience as I try to be more present at our parish of St. Gregory's. It is my intention to celebrate more weekday and weekend Masses at St. Gregory's; however, this also depends on the availability and schedules of the other priests who help us. In addition, the last weekend of each month I am presently committed to preach all the Masses at St. Matthew's as part of a bible study series that began last November.

Finally, I ask that you pray for vocations to the priesthood. The Lord Himself says in the Gospel of Luke: "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore plead with the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest" (Lk 10:2). Clearly, we cannot count on there always being a priest ready to fill a vacancy. We must pray and we must also encourage young men to consider the priesthood if they show signs of a possible vocation.

May God bless you. St. Gregory the Great, pray for us!



On Prayer, Fasting and Abstinence

These several weeks of <u>prayer</u>, <u>fasting</u> and <u>abstinence</u>—including works of charity—are in preparation to celebrate Christ's Resurrection this Easter.

All Catholics age 14 and older are obliged to <u>abstain</u> from meat on all Fridays of Lent, including the Paschal fast of Good Friday. To <u>fast</u> is to limit oneself to one full meal and two smaller meals (which together do not equal a full meal) and no solid-food snacks in-between. The drinking of ordinary fluids does not break the fast. Excused are the sick and infirm and those for whom these rules do not meet their real physical needs and who may therefore adjust their fast as necessary.
