

Guidelines for ushers both parishes

- Greet and assist parishioners in following all social distancing and safety measures
- Ushers must sanitize their hands before and after Mass
- Ushers will assist parishioners in finding seating in the church using all safety norms

Procedures and other information pertinent to Mass

- Ushers must NOT shake hands or offer an embrace to those gathering.
- There will be NO passing of the basket for the collection
- There will be NO bringing of the bread and wine to altar in procession. The bread and wine will be located in the sanctuary for the server
- The ushers are to secure the collection and place in the safe after Mass.
- There will be collection baskets placed at the doors of the church.
- Distribution of Holy Communion
 - Distribution will take place in the back of the church and the front of the church.
 - Ushers will move to the first row of pews, and to the middle of the church. We will have an indicator on the pew for the 'middle of the church'
 - Ushers will release one row at a time alternating between the left and right side.
 - Communion in the front of the church will begin with the first rows
 - Communion for the back of the church will begin in the middle of the church.
- Ushers will dismiss people after Mass from back to front.
