No Public Mass guidelines update from Archbishop Schnurr.

The following is an update from the archbishop concerning the policies that are to be followed for no public Mass.

- 1. A deacon may assist, with due concern for those deacons in a higher risk category.
- 2. When possible, another minister may assist as a reader, with due concern for those in higher risk category
- 3. Music, especially in liturgies that are live-streamed and for Holy Week services, the assistance of 1 or 2 cantors can be beneficial, as well as use of the organ.
- 4. No Mass may have more than 10 people in attendance and all social distancing norms must be followed.

Considering these guidelines, the Live Streamed Masses from Transfiguration will have the following:

All daily Masses and Sunday Masses, the priest will be accompanied by the seminarian, Curtis Gross.

Palm Sunday will have two cantors, the seminarian and 1 or 2 lectors.

Holy Thursday will have 2 cantors, the seminarian and 1 or 2 lectors

Good Friday will have 2 cantors, the seminarian, 1 or 2 lectors.

Easter Vigil will have 2 lectors, 2 cantors, an organist and the seminarian.

Easter Sunday will consist of 2 cantors, an organist, 1 lector and the seminarian.
