

October is the month of the Holy Rosary. The rosary has been part of our tradition for many centuries. Make an effort to pray the rosary especially during this month. The rosary is prayed publicly before each of the weekday Masses beginning around 7:30 a.m. **and also on Thursday evening at 7:00 p.m. in the church.**

Our total mortgage obligation is \$155,862.04. The amount owed this month is \$1802.60 with \$1412.94 being the principal and \$398.66 being the interest. The church mortgage is \$55,862.04 of that total amount. So, we are happily on the home stretch to paying off the church mortgage. The remaining amount is for the new rectory purchased last year. The mortgages were combined at that time.
