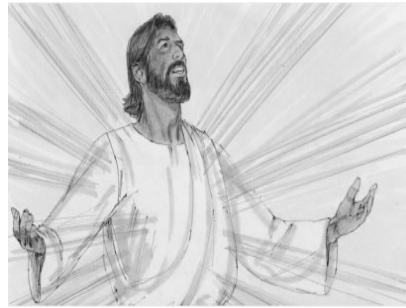

## Tri-Parish News

### What an Incredible Response

Thank you to the parishioners from our tri-parish community who supported our efforts to provide lasagna, desserts, plates and cups, beverages, salad dressing, vegetables, and plastic utensils for the SSJN meal on April 29<sup>th</sup>. We collected 43 pans of lasagna, 30 desserts, 1,750 paper plates, 1000 paper cups, 570 plastic utensils, 9 large size bottles of beverage, 9 large bottles of salad dressing, 10 packets of napkins, and 31 #10 cans of vegetables! For the dinner we utilized 20 pans of the lasagna and many of the desserts. The lasagna we did not use for this meal was placed in the freezer for a future meal. The extra desserts will be used as treats for SSJNN's after school programs. All the other items will be used for upcoming meals. Your purchase of these items saves the SSJNN meal a significant expense. A thank you also goes out to the individuals who contributed \$240 to the SSJNN Monday meal program. This money will allow the program to buy the meat and other food items for upcoming meals.

We fed approximately 100 individuals and 3 of them stuck their heads in the kitchen to comment on what a wonderful meal it was for them. One man said he hadn't had lasagna in ages and it was delicious. We are scheduled for another meal on July 29<sup>th</sup>. We will purchase hot dogs and buns and provide a picnic style meal. Information related to this event will be provided in early July

Hunger remains an issue in our community and so the Tri-parish will continue to work with the SSJNN to meet this need. Thank you for answering God's call to serve your neighbors. The Tri-parish Outreach Team.
