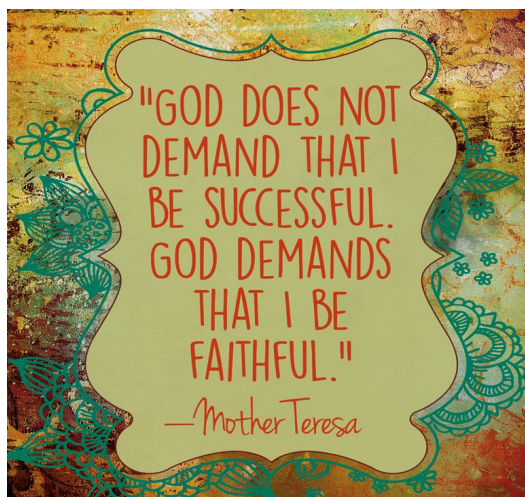
Families of College Students:
