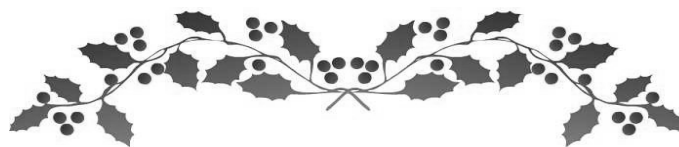
WHO: Parent/child and grandparent/grandchild teams
