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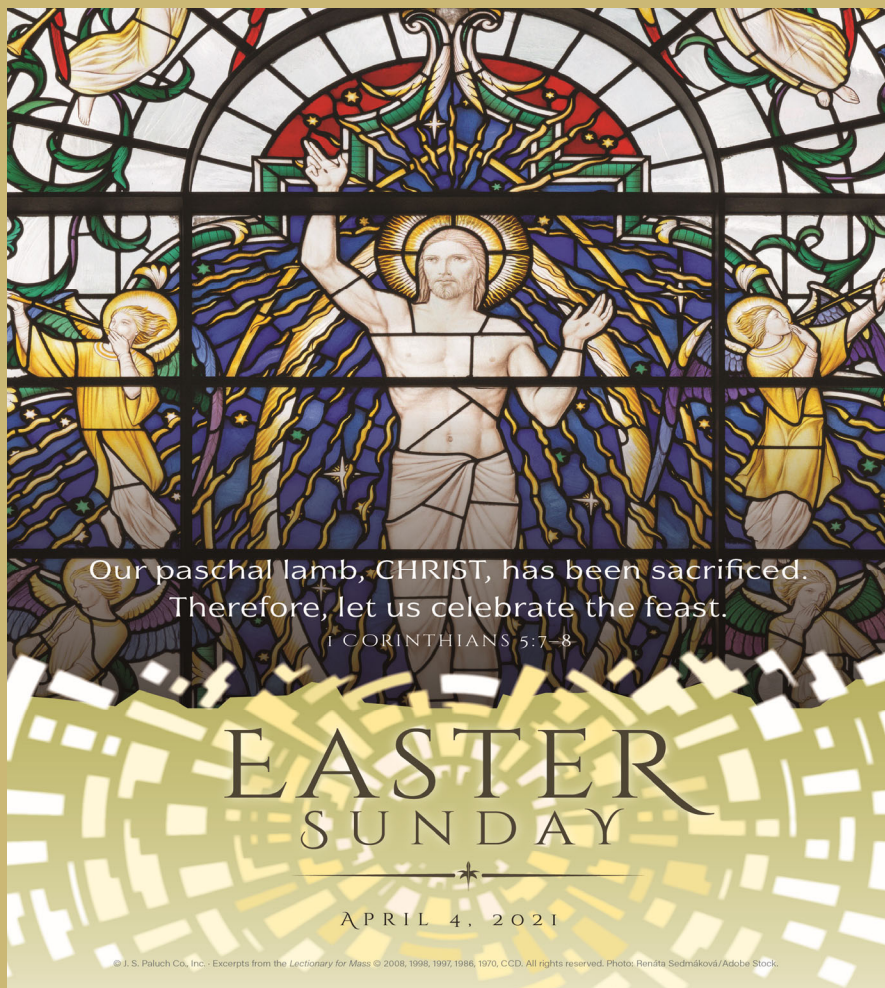

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

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Brothers and Sisters,

A year ago at this time, parishes all over our country and beyond were unable to host parishioners for Mass including during Holy Week. In the Diocese of Orlando we watched Bishop John Noonan celebrate the Triduum on *YouTube* and participated in the liturgies by way of spiritual communion. As a pastor, observing the holiest days of the year away from the parish and all the parishioners was one of the hardest things I have ever done. While I benefited from the time I spent in prayer and quiet reflection, it really wore down my battery, even though I was fully rested.

For more than a year now, there is one thing that public health officials around the world agree on...that by washing your hands with soap and water throughout the day, you will reduce the chances of taking germs into the body when you touch your face. Think about that for a minute. While the world has invested billions of dollars in the race for developing and distributing the vaccines to the world, one of the best ways to ward off the virus is by something that is accessible to us all by carefully washing our hands throughout the day.

This Easter Sunday the church invites us to not only wash ourselves clean of the virus, but of all things that keep us from God. A blessed water will be sprinkled on us, and also we will renew the promises of the Holy Baptism, by which we once renounced Satan and his works and promised to serve God in our holy Catholic Church.

If there are elements of our home life that keep us from God now is the time to wash that away. If there are elements of our professional life that keep us from God now is the time to wash that away. If there are elements of our life in the community that keep us from seeing God now is the time we wash that away. Finally, if there are elements of our parish life or parish school life that keep us from seeing God now is the time to wash that away.

It is an honor and privilege to celebrate the Easter season with you as your pastor. Let us all take the time to wash ourselves in the Spirit throughout each day from now through Pentecost and beyond in 2021. On behalf of both the school and parish staff, the Deacons and Fr. Martin Fitzgerald, Fr. Stan Murray, Fr. Joe Long, Fr. Michael Farrell and Fr. Jerome Dillon, I wish you all a glorious and happy Easter.

### Father Eamon's Commentary for Easter Sunday April 4, 2021 B

**Opening prayer:** *O Light of Lights, Risen Jesus, enter our hearts with your Good News. Enlighten our minds to understand that you have overcome death by your own dying and rising. Melt our frozen hearts with this Easter fire, that in our hearts of flesh we might come to believe that you forgive even our sins. Help us to see your presence everywhere as the first light of dawn beams upon our clouded vision. O Radiant Light, be in our midst as we gather to more clearly hear your Word of Life. Amen.*

**GOSPEL: John 20:1-9** (Let us listen with our hearts to what Jesus is saying to us.)

#### Commentary

Commenting on today's Gospel, Terence Keegan writes:

*In the prologue of John's Gospel one reads, "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it" (1:5). This image of darkness and light, as also the images death/life and falsehood/truth, recur throughout the Gospel and lie behind the story of today's reading. Mary Magdalene comes "while it is still dark" and mistakenly thinks that "the Lord has been taken from the tomb" (20:2). Simon Peter saw the piece of cloth rolled up (20:7); hardly something that anyone stealing the body would have done, but apparently did not know what to make of this strange clue. The other disciple, when he entered, not only saw but also believed. This belief is the first instance of Resurrection faith in John's Gospel. In the language of the fourth Gospel, faith is the way in which an individual passes from darkness into light, from death to life, from falsehood to truth. Faith does not result from deduction but is a gift from God bestowed in virtue of the triumphant death/ Resurrection of Jesus.*

*The author is careful to emphasize the extraordinary nature of this faith in the final verse of today's reading. Only when this gift is received, only when one has entered into the light, does the full meaning of the words of the Old Testament and the mysterious words and deeds of Jesus become clear. Only then does the significance of the rolled-up cloth become clear. Today's story is not about the disciples interpreting the empty tomb, but rather about the initial gift of faith by which one enters into the light, the truth and the life of Jesus' Resurrection.*

#### Questions:

What word/phrase stuck out to you in the gospel?

How do you think that word/phrase relates to what is happening in your life right now?

Is Jesus asking you to change something to be a better person or do something to help someone else?

**Closing prayer:** "May your Word grow strong in our hearts. Amen." Father Eamon Tobin
