Sign of the Cross

The Apostles' Creed

Leader: I believe in God,
the Father almighty,
Creator of heaven and earth,
and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died and was buried;
He descended into hell;

Leader: Hail, Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee.

Blessed art thou among women
and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

Participants: Holy Mary, Mother of God,
pray for us sinners,
now and at the hour of our death. Amen

The Glory Be

Leader: Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit,

Participants: as it was in the beginning Is now, and ever shall be
world without end. Amen.

Fatima Prayer (pray at the end of each decade)

Altogether: O My Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell and lead
all souls to Heaven, especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy.

Leader Reflection: In today’s gospel, we hear the familiar story of Jesus teaching
in the synagogue of his native place and their taking offense at him. Jesus “was
amazed at their lack of faith.”

We thank God for all those who serve at Social Concerns and all those who
contribute to Social Concerns that so many in our community may simply live.
Last year Social Concerns disbursed \$226,826, helping 3,665 families representing
8,397 individuals.
