#### **The Apostles' Creed**

**Leader:** I believe in God,  
the Father almighty,  
Creator of heaven and earth,  
and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,  
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,  
born of the Virgin Mary,  
suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died and was buried;  
He descended into hell;  
on the third day he rose again from the dead;  
He ascended into heaven,  
and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty;  
from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

#### **The Our Father**

**Leader:** Our Father who art in heaven,

**Leader:** Hail, Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee.

and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.

**Participants:** Holy Mary, Mother of God,

pray for us sinners,

now and at the hour of our death. Amen

**The Glory Be**

**Leader:** Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit,

**Participants:** as it was in the beginning Is now, and ever shall be world without end. Amen.

**Fatima Prayer** (pray at the end of each decade)

O My Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of Hell and lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who are in most need of Thy mercy.

#### REFLECTION

The Glorious Mysteries specifically honor Mary for her primary role in Jesus' life. In "Rosarium Virginis Mariae", Saint Pope John Paul II wrote about the Glorious Mysteries, "23. *The contemplation of Christ's face cannot stop at the image of the Crucified One. He is the Risen One!*" 29 *The Rosary has always expressed this knowledge born of faith and invited the believer to pass beyond the darkness of the Passion in order to gaze upon Christ's glory in the Resurrection and Ascension. Contemplating the Risen One, Christians rediscover the reasons for their own faith (cf. 1 Cor 15:14) and relive the joy not only of those to whom Christ appeared—the Apostles, Mary Magdalene and the disciples on the road to Emmaus—but also the joy of Mary, who must have had an equally intense experience of the new life of her glorified Son.*"
