Course Description

6-9 Formation Course Objectives

- To present the methodology and guiding principles of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd as it especially pertains to the 6 to 9 year old child, including Sacramental Preparation for Reconciliation and Eucharist.
- To explore the religious nature and most vital religious needs of the 6 to 9 year old child.
- To meditate on the Biblical and Liturgical themes presented to the 6 to 9 year old child.
- To offer guidelines and assistance preparing the 6 to 9 year Atrium environment, and in making the catechists' album and catechetical material.

Certification

This approximately 90 hour course is designed to be a spiritual formation experience and instruction. Successful completion of this course will result in a certificate from the National Association of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. **Note:** The basis for this work is founded in the Roman Catholic tradition. The scope of the formation course is presented with respect to this tradition. A formation course in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, however, includes a dialogue and respect for participants from other traditions as we share what is most essential about our Christian faith and how it is met in this work of spiritual formation for children.


Formation Leader
