

ADORATION COVID PROTOCOL

Effective May 1st, the Adoration Chapel is open 23/7. Only 2 confirmed adorers are permitted each hour. No **DROP-INS!** The Adoration Chapel is sanitized every day by Ascension staff from 6:00 am to 7:00 am. A Hepa filtration system is in place to help clean the air during the hours of adoration. **Masks are required** and must always be worn over your nose and mouth while in the chapel. Although there are no guarantees that you will not get the covid disease, we ask that you follow the protocol below, to try and keep everyone safe.

Adoration Protocol

1. Enter the code on the outside door and enter the chapel. Once inside, sanitize your hands. If you are the first adorer, enter the chapel. All subsequent adorers must **knock** on the inside door (on the hour) to alert the previous adorers of your arrival. Wait at the "X" (6' back for social distancing) to allow room for adorers to depart before entering the chapel.
2. It is best to bring your own pen for signing in. Pens will be provided if you don't have one. Please place used pens in "dirty pen" cup. Sign-in is required for possible contact tracing if necessary.
3. If you are the first to arrive, open the Tabernacle and expose the Monstrance. Do not remove it from the Tabernacle. If you are the last, or if there is no one to replace you after your hour, please cover the Monstrance and close the Tabernacle.
4. Please be mindful of the time and be prepared to leave when your hour is up by sanitizing everything that you have physically come in contact with including the door handles and number keypad.
