

Homily

Nicene Creed

I believe in one God, the Father, the almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible, I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified; who has spoken through the prophets. 
