11. Faith Formation update by Joan & Fr. Denny

- a. Father reported that RCIA has 10 -11 people attending on Wed. evenings, many of whom are Catholics that are learning more about their faith. Michelle Peppel and Sheila Steffel are in charge.
 - b. Suzy Haubrich noted that VBS went very well and the kids really seemed to enjoy it. Joan reported that 41 kids, about 20 adults, and 10 teens help with VBS
 - c. We are still looking for catechist for grades 7 & 8 and someone to help with “office duties” during classes.
 - d. The AFC Faith Formation will conducting a fundraiser making and selling pumpkin pies and apple crisp during Nov.
 - i. They will be made the weekend before Thanksgiving to be picked up after Masses that same weekend.
 - ii. Margaret suggest to make the crusts on Wed. The will be sold by pre-orders in Nov.
 - iii. Margaret also suggested getting pie tins from B & D Market to ensure the sturdiness.
 - iv. The money earned will be split half & half for youth and adult faith formation.
 - v. We are planning to take some youth to a Stubbenville conference in the summer, and will be using some of the money to offset the cost.
 - vi. We are looking into a Formed subscription for the AFC for adult formation. Formed is an online program offering books, movies, bible study, and more to all parishioners in the AFC. It cost over \$1,700 and we are hoping to earn enough to cover this cost.
 - e. This year the students are served a lite supper before classes. Margaret and Mary Ann Lippert have been preparing and serving this so far.
