Welcome! Our parish Faith Formation (*Children, Youth & Adult*) & Youth Ministry Programs offer many opportunities for you and your family to continue your faith formation. Registration forms are available in the Faith Formation Office, located in the St. Stephen Catholic School building off Boyette Road (east wing). You may also download these forms from our St. Stephen website. Once registered in our program, your child will be scheduled for the class time that you requested on your form.

Please know that NO REMINDERS of starting dates or assigned classes are mailed to your home.

RETURNING STUDENTS: Please fill out the (**BLUE**) Family Form – instructions are provided. In order to receive your choice of class day and time, please register early! Class size is limited. Students are assigned day and time on a first come, first serve basis.

SIBLINGS: (brothers and sisters of returning students registering for the first time) Please fill out a **WHITE STUDENT INFORMATION FORM**. You may pick one up at the Faith Formation Office or download the form from our website. Return the (white) Student Information Form along with the (**BLUE**) Family Form for complete and proper registration.

NEW STUDENTS: Please fill out the (**GREEN**) Family Form – instructions are provided. We also need a **WHITE STUDENT INFORMATION FORM** for each child you are registering in one of our classes. MISSION

The gift of faith, which begins at Baptism, must be nourished throughout the entire life of each Catholic. Parents have the primary responsibility for training their children in the practices of our faith. Our parish Faith Formation programs assist parents in their sacred duty, and provide opportunities for families to develop their prayer lives and their formal understanding of our faith so each individual can come to his/her potential as members of the People of God.

FAITH FORMATION POLICIES

Parents are given a Faith Formation Handbook at the beginning of each year.

PARISH REGISTRATION

Families are asked to be registered members of St. Stephen Parish. Please include your Parish ID or Envelope Number on the front side of the Registration Form. If you do not know your Parish ID number, please call Sue at the Faith Formation Office 671-4434.

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION

Children beginning Kindergarten must be 5 years of age by September 1st of the year in which the student is enrolling. Children are placed in the same grade they attend in school although special considerations are made for sacrament preparation when necessary.

Parents are asked to sign the Commitment and Promise Agreement, the Photo/Video Release, the Medical Acknowledgement, and Permission to Text Messages all located on the reverse side of the Registration Form. It is essential you provide us with accurate emergency contact information and update as needed.

On the first day of class, parents will receive a calendar for the entire year. Please note the dates on this calendar, especially those dates when class will not be held. In the event of inclement weather, class is cancelled. We follow the same guidelines as Hillsborough County Public School.

The family has an essential role in preparation for and celebration of a sacrament. According to Diocesan guidelines, parents as well as children and youth are required to attend Sacrament Preparatory sessions, meet all expectations, pray daily, and attend Mass weekly as a family. Reminder notices are sent home regarding meetings, workshops, retreats, Rites, and rehearsals. Catholic School Diocesan guidelines are available in the Faith Formation Office. Classes are also offered for youth and adults who want to prepare for sacraments. Please call the Faith Formation Office to inform us of your needs.

One on one Sacrament classes are only offered for children and youth with special needs upon request. Please call the Faith Formation Office for details.

CATECHISTS

We're very fortunate to have a large number of catechists sharing their time, love, and faith with our children and youth. Teaching requires hours of planning, studying and implementing. They have entered into a partnership with you to help continue your child's faith formation. Please give them your support and prayers. Remember, we can only reinforce what is being taught at home.

Contact the Faith Formation Office if you are interested in becoming a catechist, or volunteering as one of our support staff for our many programs. Visit our web site for a list of volunteer opportunities.

Volunteer catechists are expected to handle routine classroom discipline and will not be asked to deal with situations beyond their control. Every effort will be made to instill the love of God and neighbor in your child during class. If a child is having an "off day," he/she will be sent to the Faith Formation Office for quiet reflection time. Should unruly behavior continue, parents will have to accompany their child to class.

The safety of our children and youth is of utmost importance and a top priority. **Please use caution when escorting your child to and from their classrooms. There is no car line for grade K-5.**

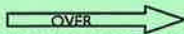

CATECHIST. (Teacher or co-teacher) Be willing to share your time and faith with the children and youth in our programs. Plan weekly lessons using the Lesson Plan Schedule and teacher's guide, as well as a variety of resource materials. Obtain supplies and attendance folder from Faith Formation supply area prior to class. Maintain order in your room.

ASSISTANT CATECHIST. Be willing to share your time and faith with the children and youth in our programs. Assist the teacher with weekly activities, discipline, and if needed, supervise the class in the teacher's absence.

NURSERY. Please arrive at least 10 minutes before class begins. Child care is provided for volunteers during class times.

RECEPTIONIST. Please arrive at least 10 minutes before class begins. Anyone entering the school building during Sunday and Wednesday K-5 classes will be asked to sign the clipboard on your table at the entrance. During class time, please check the student rest rooms and hall, and ask any lingering children to return to their classroom. Occasionally you'll be asked to collate and staple papers, etc.

SUBSTITUTES. You will be called when needed. Sometimes a teacher will inform our office of their absence at the last minute, so thank you for responding on short notice. Before proceeding to your classroom, please pick up the Attendance Folder and receive any instructions. Return folder and materials after class.

BABYSITTING at Faith Formation events. Please call our Faith Formation Office for a list of dates and let us know which events you can help with.

OFFICE ASSISTANCE. This requires a few hours each week handling routine filing, record keeping, and answering phones at the Faith Formation Office.

CLASS TIME PARTIES. Serve refreshments to the K-5 classes at the school building during class for Christmas and at the last class.

WORKSHOPS. Facilitate a small group activity during one or both family workshops for First Eucharist or First Reconciliation. Lesson plans and materials provided.

SEWING. Help sew brown and white robes for Easter Vigil, and other various Faith Formation needs. We provide the pattern & fabric.
