3. Clergy Availability

Over the coming decade, the Diocese of Scranton faces a decreasing number of priests.

A fewer number of priests represent a significant challenge. Given the decline in family size, there will be fewer priests. Changes will need to be prompted because of clergy retirement, infirmity or transfer. 16 priests are expected to reach retirement age by 2025. In 2021, there were 97 diocesan priests active in the diocese. In 2030 there are 62 projected active priests in the diocese. The more parishes work together and share ministries the better for all.


