



## Confirmation Program Dress Code

The following dress code is also suggested for the sponsors or “padrinos.” No rosaries, bibles or any other items are needed to be carried in the hands of those being confirmed. A reminder that only one sponsor or “padrino or madrina” is needed per student. You do not need a sponsor if you are also doing your First Communion the same day of your Confirmation.

### Girls

1. Girls may wear a dress or pant suit.
  - a. The dress does not have to be in any particular color (to include those doing First Communion with their Confirmation).
  - b. The dress cannot be extremely short, extremely low cut or with spaghetti straps (a shawl or jacket may be worn inside the church).
2. No jeans. If you want to wear leggings, you must wear a tunic-length shirt.
3. Jewelry in good taste may be worn.
4. Dress shoes or dress sandals.
5. No tennis shoes.
6. No rosaries, bibles or any other items are needed to be carried in the hands of those being confirmed.

### Boys

1. Boys may wear a dress shirt of any color; no jacket or tie are required.
2. Dress slacks only. No jeans.
3. Dress shoes; no tennis shoes.
4. No rosaries, bibles or any other items are needed to be carried in the hands of those being confirmed.
