

ADVENT 2023/NEW LITURGICAL YEAR

This Sunday, we enter the Advent season. Advent is the beginning of the Church's new liturgical year. It is a time when we earnestly wait for the coming of the Lord—first, as the Incarnate Son of God, born to us; and second, His final coming as Judge of the living and the dead. Advent is a season of hope and penance. We may want to hold on with throwing out the Christmas decorations until—at the earliest—the Third Sunday of Advent when Advent turns to joy at the Lord's coming.



SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION

The Universal Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary this coming Friday, 8th December. The Church in the United States has Immaculate Conception as her patroness. Universally, this feast is observed as a Holy Day of Obligation. Please make plans to attend any of the two Masses scheduled for the Holy Day at 8:00am or 5:30pm. Eucharistic Adoration will be held after the 5:30pm Mass.



CELEBRATION OF OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

This year's feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe falls on a Tuesday. To ensure greater participation, we will be celebrating the feast next Saturday, December 9th. All are invited. Mass will be at 5:00pm, followed by a host of activities inside the auditorium. Come and enjoy a great fellowship.


ORDER YOUR SHIRT FOR THE COMING FEAST
