
HEADING TOWARD 2024

CELEBRATION MARY MOTHER OF GOD

While January 1 is New Year Day in the temporal calendar, the Church observes it as the **Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God.** The Council of Ephesus in the year 431 declared Mary as the "Theotokos" or "Godbearer"— a name which expresses the love which God poured into Mary to enable her to love so fully in her turn. We will have a 9:00 am Mass on New Year day to celebrate this feast.
