

Love Life Guidelines

The Love Life Program is available to low-income families with children under three years of age.

1. Required Enrollment Information

- A. () Proof of your Address, such as a current WPS, Water Dept. or other bill.
- B. () A picture I. D. such as a current driver's license.
- C. () A birth certificate of your child(ren), who is/are **under three years of age**.
- D. () A current WIC folder or an agency referral.

2. If any of the above information is not provided at the initial interview, it must be provided at the next visit. A temporary card will be issued for one time use. The missing information is required before further participation in the program. If a person recommends Love Life to a friend or relative, they should tell them about the required information so that they can bring it in on their first visit.

3. When all needed information is furnished, participants will receive a permanent card which must be presented to receive gifts from the program. If it is forgotten a temporary card will be issued for the day at the intake desk. After two such occasions, a fee of \$1.00 will be charged. If a permanent card is lost, a \$1.00 fee will be charged for a replacement.

4. The permanent card allows participants to come twice a month for:

- A. Diapers – one pack per child.
- B. Three articles of clothing per child, per visit.
- C. Other items such as shoes, bottles, books, toys as available.

In addition, families may receive one large item such as a high chair, stroller, etc. (depending on availability) per 12 month period. Parents-to-be and new parents may receive a layette for their newborn.

5. Once a child reaches three years of age, that child is no longer eligible to receive diapers. An exception is available for special needs children with a doctor's approval required. See intake desk for more information. **Families are no longer eligible for the program once their youngest child reaches the age of three.** An exception exists for special needs children

6. Love Life hours are every Thursday with the exception of fifth Thursdays of the month. Hours are from 1:00 P.M. until 4:00 P.M. **Participants should try to arrive no later than 3:45 to give ample time to process their needs.**
