Will you let me answer prayer in you and you in me?

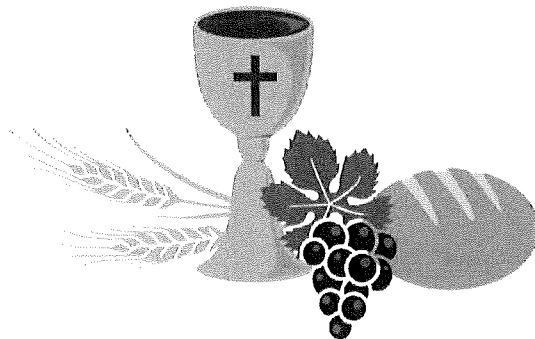
